# **GROCERIES (A SHORT DRIVE)**


Auto Mercado is a large, clean grocery store about 5 minutes down the hill. A pharmacy is located inside the store, as well as a bakery, and an extensive liquor selection. You can't go wrong with Auto Mercado. International credit cards are accepted here and in most other places as well.

# **UBER EATS**

You can have food delivered to CCG using the Uber Eats app. A bit more expensive, but sometimes worth it.

# HALF-DAYS IN NATURE

## POAS VOLCANO

- The world's largest open volcano in a popular national park
- A spectacular view of the rain-fed lake at the bottom of the crater
- One of the most accessible spots to experience the cloud forest
- 40 min north of CCG
- Go early in the morning!

## LA PAZ WATERFALLS

- Costa Rica's most visited nature park and animal sanctuary
- Lush rain forests, waterfalls, animals and butterfly exhibit
- 3.5 km of walking trails
- Restaurant on-site
- 20 min from Poas Volcano, 45 min from CCG
- · Can be combined with a trip to Poaz

# EI ARCA VIVERO - THE ARC HERB FARM

- Beautiful botanical garden and nursery for plant lovers
- Take a guided tour to learn about the many uses of plants, including food, medicine, dyes, oils, and much more.
- A 30 min scenic drive from CCG



## **DOKA COFFEE ESTATE**

- Largest coffee plantation in Costa Rica
- Discover the process of growing high quality coffee and the environmental and cultural practices surrounding it
- Coffee tastings, butterfly exhibit, bonsai garden, walking trails, gift shop, and cafeteria
- 15 min drive north

# HACIENDA ALSACIA -STARBUCKS COFFEE FARM

- A large, gorgeous coffee farm dedicated to research, sustainability, local outreach, and education.
- Informative coffee tour
- Cafe and gift shop.
- 10 min drive north

- Activities include a petting zoo, pony rides, suspension bridge, zipline, and stream with trout fishing and beautiful views.
- Food is available at the farm
- 20 min drive north

- Home to thousands of endangered, injured, and stray animals.
- Walk the extensive grounds to enjoy the large variety of animals
- Restaurant on-site
- 20 min drive west
